

2009/2010 TENNIS EAST GIPPSLAND JUNIOR TOURNAMENT CIRCUIT

CONDITIONS GOVERNING APPROVAL TO CLUBS

The Applicant Club agrees:

1. to accept the decision of Tennis East Gippsland.
2. the application for approval to conduct a tournament form must contain all information.
3. agrees to pay Tennis East Gippsland the amount of \$2 per player per tournament where the club conducts the event, or \$5 per player if Tennis East Gippsland conduct the event.
4. agrees to conduct a canteen for morning tea and lunch.
5. The club agree to display the Tennis East Gippsland logo in a prominent position during the tournament.

CONDITIONS GOVERNING CONDUCT OF TOURNAMENT(S)

1. Tournament(s) shall be conducted in accordance with Tennis Victoria Regulations.
2. The code of conduct as approved by Tennis Australia will be enforced during tournament(s).
3. Tournament(s) shall be under the sole control of the Regional Council which shall have the power to reject any entry without stating the reason.
4. Events shall be conducted as prescribed feed-in or round robin events.
5. The approved Tournament Draw form shall be used.
6. **Entrant numbers may be limited dependent upon available courts.**
7. Where entrant numbers are limited, players with better entry records shall have precedence.
8. The length of matches shall be, with 10/U being 6 game sets with tiebreaker at 5-all, and 12/U, 14/U and 16/U being 8 game sets with tiebreaker at 7-all.
9. The player entry fee into a tournament is \$7 payable to the sanctioned club.
10. The Tennis East Gippsland Heat Out and Wash Out Policy applies.
11. Players shall be the age or under at 31st March 2010.
12. Points will be allotted to each match of a tournament, with each player commencing a year with no points.
13. The top eight (8) points scorers in the Circuit tournaments will qualify to compete in the Masters Tournament to be held at Bairnsdale on 14th March 2010.
14. Where a top eight qualifier is unable to take his or her place in the Masters Tournament, the next highest points qualifier will be invited.
15. In the event of a tie between players in the number of points earned to take up the eighth position, each of the tied players will be invited to take a place in the Masters Tournament.
16. **Entry and results in Circuit tournaments will be a major factor taken into account in selecting juniors seeking a position in a TEG representative team.**
