International Tennis Number (ITN)  <small>International Tennis Number</small> This tournament ITN 4 and above	1	N/A	<i>This player has had intensive training for national tournament competition at the junior and senior levels. Holds or is capable of holding an ATP/WTA ranking and major source of income is through tournament prize money.</i>
	2	N/A	<i>This player has developed power and/or consistency as a major weapon. Can vary strategies and styles of play in a competitive situation.</i>
	3	Open	<i>This player has good shot anticipation and frequently has an outstanding shot or attribute around which a game may be structured. Can regularly hit winners and force errors off short balls. Can put away volleys and smashes and impart spin on second serves.</i>
	4	Grade A open	<i>This player has begun to master the use of power and spin and is beginning to handle pace. Has sound footwork. Can control depth of shots and is beginning to vary game plan according to opponents. Can hit first serves with power and can place second serves.</i>
	5	Grade B Open 18 & Under	<i>This player has dependable strokes, including directional control and depth on both ground strokes and on moderate shots. Has the ability to use lobs, overheads, approach shots and volleys with some success.</i>
	6	Grade C Open 16 & Under	<i>This player exhibits more aggressive net play, has improved court coverage, improved shot control and is developing teamwork in doubles.</i>
	7	14 & Under	<i>This player is fairly consistent when hitting medium paced shots but is not yet comfortable with all strokes. Lacks control over depth, direction and power.</i>
	8	12 & Under	<i>This player is learning to judge where the ball is going and can sustain a short rally of slow pace.</i>
	9	N/A	<i>This player needs on court experience. Familiar with basic positions in singles and doubles play.</i>
	10	N/A	<i>This player is just starting to play tennis and is working primarily on getting the ball into play.</i>
