Our Regional meeting was held today between 3.00 and 4.45 pm.

There are many important issues canvassed in these documents reflecting a very positive direction for Tennis Victoria and TEG but immediate issues are:

New Regional Name

A contest will be conducted to choose a more relevant name, and logo, for the Region to better reflect the municipal constituents including Wellington and East Gippsland Shire Councils. A valuable prize will be offered and the contest will close on 30th June 2009. The contest is open to affiliated clubs and affiliated players. Full particulars of the contest will be conveyed to you in the next couple of weeks.

2009/10 Regional Pennant

The Region will conduct a pre-Christmas Summer Pennant comprising 6 teams of 5 players (3 male and 2 female).

The season will be of 10 weeks duration commencing on Saturday 10th October 2009 with 10 home and away rounds plus a finals day involving all teams on Saturday 19th December. The full format details are to be finalised and we are approaching these with flexibility, however, it is likely that 2 males and 1 female will play a singles match (and doubles) each week, and 1 male and 1 female will play doubles only. Further details will be provided to clubs in the near future.

Teams will be offered optional daylight saving start times as late at 3 pm.

The Regional Council encourages associations/clubs to consider events/activities to attract these, and other, players after Christmas, but in the absence of these being identified in a reasonable timeframe, a post-Christmas Summer Pennant for 6 teams will be offered from Saturday 6th February to Saturday 20th March 2010 plus a final day involving all teams on Saturday 27th March.
